





ON THE TRAIN

DEPART MALAGA FOR GRANADA TO JOIN THE TRAIN

On your first day aboard the Tren Al Andalus, our team will welcome you at 10:00 am at the AC Hotel by Marriott Málaga Palacio. Later, we'll board the train again, heading towards Linares-Baeza station, savoring a splendid dinner en route.



VISIT ÚBEDA & BAEZA & TRAVEL ON TO CÓRDOBA



TOUR CÓRDOBA & HEAD INTO THE HILLS TO RONDA



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- There is a minimum number of participants required for a trip to run. It is rare this number is not reached.
- Due to the intricate logistics of this tour, itinerary changes are sometimes unavoidable.
- On booking a non-refundable deposit of 15% of the total tour price plus any international flights we are booking for you. Full payment is required 35 days before the trip start date.
- International flights, tips, beverages, visa fees and any services not mentioned are not included in the price.

Cancellation conditions:

- More than 30 days before the trip: 15% penalty.
- Between 30 and 15 days before the trip: 25% penalty. The remaining 75% will be refunded.
- Between 14 and 5 days before the trip: 50% penalty. The remaining 50% will be refunded.
- Between 4 and 1 day before the trip: 80% penalty. The remaining 20% will be refunded.
- Less than 24 hours or no-show on the day of the start of the trip: 100% penalty. No amount will be refunded.

Its four saloons, real railroad jewels built between 1928 and 1930, are the perfect scenario in which the breakfast à la carte and selected dinners and three course meals are served. 

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE TOUR

HOW FAR IN ADVANCE DO I NEED TO BOOK?

This train tour is an exclusive trip with very limited departures through the year. Consequently we strongly advise our clients to book as far in advance as possible to avoid disappointment. This particularly applies to the higher level cabins which there is strong demand for.

CAN YOU OBTAIN & ADVISE ON THE VISAS FOR US?

Visas (if required) can be quite complex so we recommend using a specialist visa agent and have an arrangement with CIBT Visa Central who offer a reliable service for all the visas you will need for your trip. Of course, we provide all the necessary documentation which must accompany your application.

ARE YOUR TOURS FINANCIALLY PROTECTED?

Yes! All our trips come with financial protection either through our ATOL if the trip includes a flight or insurances which comply with the UK package travel regulations for any trip that does not include a flight. In addition our ABTA membership means we must adhere to their strict code of conduct.

CAN YOU BOOK INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FOR US?

Absolutely! Our ATOL license means that we can book international or indeed internal flights. We get particularly good access to the best deals on British Airways as we are an appointed operator. Just let us know which airports you want to fly from or to and we will be more than happy to give a quote.

CAN YOU BOOK FURTHER TRAVEL FOR US?

Yes! We can offer extensions to further explore Africa at either end of the trip. Just ask us for details.

WHAT CURRENCY TO TAKE?

The legal currency in Spain is Euro.

CAN I SMOKE ON BOARD?

Smoking is not possible on board the train, current legislation prohibits it. However, journeys do not exceed 3-4 hours of duration.

DOES THE TRAIN TRAVEL AT NIGHT?

No, to provide optimal rest, the train will stand at the station and resume the journey in the morning.

LUGGAGE & CLOTHING TO BRING

No mandatory dress code is required, you can dress as you wish. Guided walking tours are included to get to know the cities, so we recommend wearing comfortable clothes and shoes during the day. Depending on the time of year, bring a raincoat and warm clothes. For evenings an elegant or casual dress would be the best option.

HOW MANY PASSENGERS ARE THERE?

The train supports up to 64 passengers.

IS THERE WIFI

Yes, there is Wi-Fi on board and there is also a computer in the lounges from which you can access the Internet.



USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE TOUR

TIPPING

There is no obligation to tip staff. If you wish, you are free to do so.

MEDICAL & HEALTH

The train has a first-aid kit and the crew is trained to know how to use it in an emergency. However, if you need medical attention, we can refer you to one of the health centres located along the route. Spanish citizens will benefit from health care according to Spanish Social Security rules. Citizens of the European Union should consult the agreements with each country (there is usually reciprocity). For citizens of other nationalities, we recommend taking out medical insurance to cover possible health emergencies.

LAUNDRY

Small towels and sheeting is provided. Laundry and ironing services are on board at an additional charge payable locally.

DINING CAR & DRINKS

Breakfast is served on board and consists of both a table service and a varied buffet, all prepared with high quality products. The breakfast menu includes a wide variety of items that are freshly prepared to serve. Lunch and dinner are a combination of meals on board and meals in first-class restaurants. In any case, there is a selection of high quality cuisine on offer, with typical dishes from the areas where train travels.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

If you are allergic to certain foods, or require vegetarian or other meals, just give written notice at the time of booking. We will ensure that meals are tailored to your preferences and needs.

WHAT SOCKETS ARE THERE?

The power supply in Spain is 230 V 50 Hz, with two cylindrical plugs F-type sockets.

IS THERE SECURITY?

Trains have a safety deposit box. The stations where the train is parked there are surveillance systems.

WHAT ID DO I NEED ?

For foreigners, the documentation required to travel by train is the same as that required to enter Spain from the country of origin. Spanish citizens can identify themselves with their national identity card or passport.

HOW ACCESSIBLE IS THE TRAIN?

The Transcantabrico is a historic train, and although it is restored to offer maximum comfort, the inside is not adapted for a wheelchair or walker to move around. However, travel would be possible for a person with reduced mobility who is reasonably self-sufficient or travelling with another passenger, who only requires the support of a wheelchair, once out of the train. However, it is important that these people do not travel without help, and that their travel companion is available to help with boarding, pushing the wheelchair, etc, as there are no dedicated staff available for this purpose.

CAN I TRAVEL WITH A BABY?

In this case, you must booking a triple Deluxe Suite Room, adding the supplement for the baby.








AS I WALKED OUT ONE MIDSUMMER MORNING

GILES TREMLETT



GEORGE ORWELL


In 1936 George Orwell travelled to Spain to report on the Civil War and instead joined the fight against the Fascists. This famous account describes the war and Orwell's own experiences.

ERNEST HEMINGWAY



JOHN HOOPER


